# Field Trip around the Venice Lagoon 31st May 2017

The boat trip will **start at CNR-ISMAR** and it will **end at San Giorgio island** (social dinner location), with **no stop in between**. Therefore, consider that your dress code should be compliant, since the morning, both with the boat trip and the final visit of the St. Mark's Basilica.

What concerns the **boat trip**, please, take into account the following suggestions:

- bring with you what needed to be protected from the sun (hat/sunglasses/sun cream),
- wear closed and comfortable shoes (preferably no high hills);

What concerns the night **visit of the St. Mark's Basilica**, take into account that visitors are recommended to respect the sacred place, in particular:

- Clothes be appropriate for a place of worship;
- You cannot enter the basilica with luggage. Luggage must be deposited in Ateneo San Basso (Piazzetta dei Leoncini in front of the Gate of Flowers, north facade);
- Photos and filming are forbidden;
